## **Application Process**

	Review the EMU-Lancaster dual enrollment requirements to ensure you are able to participate. You must meet the following requirements: Successfully completed (B or
	better) at least some of the academically challenging coursework offered by high school
	Schedule a meeting with your counselor to discuss if dual enrollment is the right fit for
	you.
	Complete the School District of Lancaster Dual Enrollment Request form and get your
	counselor and campus administration's approval. You can get a request form from the
	Future Ready Center (JP 147, East A126), the counseling office, or online at
	www.tinyurl.com/SDoLDualEnroll
	Once approved, visit the Future Ready Center to discuss next steps.
	Complete the EMU-Lancaster registration form. Applications are available online at
	https://emu.edu/lancaster/gened/enrollment/registration.
	Complete the Student Academic Eligibility form from EMU-Lancaster. This requires
	signatures from you, your parent/guardian, and your counselor or a principal. You can
	find the form at <u>www.tinyurl.com/EMUAcademic</u> .
	Once you receive your confirmation of acceptance, work with your counselor to select a
	course that aligns with your high school schedule.

	Follow directions provided by EMU-Lancaster to set up your Moodle and email
	accounts.
