Application Process

	Review the Elizabethtown College dual enrollment requirements to ensure you are able to participate. You must meet the following requirements: 10 th grade or higher, 10 th grade
	students must be "exceptional" students and come with a letter of recommendation, must
	be making satisfactory progress towards completing high school requirements as defined
_	by SDoL.
	Schedule a meeting with your counselor to discuss if dual enrollment is the right fit for you.
	Complete the School District of Lancaster Dual Enrollment Request form and get your
	counselor and campus administration's approval. You can get a request form from the
	Future Ready Center (JP 147, East A126), the counseling office, or online at
	www.tinyurl.com/SDoLDualEnroll
	Once approved, visit the Future Ready Center to discuss next steps.
	Complete the Elizabethtown College application. Applications are available online at
	https://www.etown.edu/admissions/high-school.aspx.
	Request a copy of your transcript be sent to Elizabethtown College. You must request
	this from your counselor in person or via Xello.
	Once you receive your confirmation of acceptance, work with your counselor to select a
	course that aligns with your high school schedule.

	Follow directions provided by Elizabethtown College to set up Canvas and Jayweb
	accounts.
	Purchase your course textbooks. Identify the courses you need at
	https://www.etown.edu/programs/college-store/textbooks.aspx. You can purchase these
	books directly from Elizabethtown or on your own elsewhere.
	Attend the high school dual enrollment orientation. All students are required to attend,
	this typically takes place within one of the start of classes.
