

# How to apply to Lancaster County Career and Technology Center (CTC)



Programs in practical nursing, construction technologies, veterinary technology, dentistry & more!

## 1. Go to [www.lancasterctc.edu](http://www.lancasterctc.edu) and click on “Apply Now” in the top right



## 2. Scroll to down the page and click on “Adult Education Student Portal”

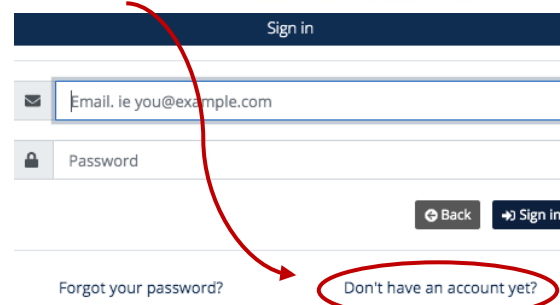

## 3. Select your program of interest and click on the image to see the program dates



## 4. Scroll down and click on “Apply” and then “Don’t have an account?” to make your account

- Before applying, check the program dates and times. If the class is full you can only select “show interest”
- Create your account **using an email you check often**, and a password between 4-10 characters.
- **Verify your email** by clicking on the “verify email” button in your inbox
- Select “Register”, and then sign in using your email and new password.



## 5. Select “apply” again to start the application

## 6. Scroll down to click “I agree” & begin completing your application

- **Only questions with \* are required.** Once submitted make sure you speak with your counselor and ask them to **send your high school transcript**.
- It is highly recommended to complete the application in October or November as they will be considered on a first come first serve basis.

## 7. Submit the required documents for your program listed in the application portal

- The documents vary by program, but all programs will require the following documents:
- **Current and final high school transcript:** Email your school counselor to get a signed copy of your final transcript and submit it in your application portal.
- **Background clearances:** PA Child Abuse History, PA State Police, and FBI Federal Criminal History checks are the 3 clearances required. Each clearance is linked in the student portal.

## 8. Placement testing

- **As a new applicant, you will need to take the Accuplacer Placement Assessment.** Accuplacer is the required pre-entrance test for all full-time applicants. It is a basic college level assessment and is self-timed. You can practice at <https://accuplacer.collegeboard.org/educator/next-generation>
  - You may be exempt from this test if you have a Math SAT and Reading SAT score of 480 or higher. You must submit proof.

**\*Your application can only be reviewed for admission after all documents and placement tests are complete.**
