# How to apply to Harrisburg Area Community College:



### 1. Go to www.hacc.edu and click on apply on the left side

#### 2. Create an account

- Complete your registration information.
- Create your login credentials.





- Be sure to use your legal name as it appears on official school documents and standardized tests. This will make sure the school can match documents to the correct person.
- At the end, it will ask you what your plan at HACC will be.
  - a. When do you plan to start classes at HACC?
    - i. Summer  $2022 June\ 2022$
    - ii. Fall 2022 August 2022

\*Most students enroll Fall 2022

- iii. Spring 2023 January 2023
- b. Which campus do you plan to attend?
  - i. **Make sure that your program of choice is offered at the campus you want to go to.** For example, the dental hygiene program can only be completed at HACC Harrisburg.
- c. Academic Program
  - i. Select what you want to major in.
    - \* Undecided or just completing general requirements before transferring? Select General Studies!
- Select "Create Account" to complete your account!

### 3. Select "Create a new application"

- Choose your registration type if you are applying to college for the first time you'll select the "Start a general application" button.
- Complete all the of the sections

# 5. Placement testing

- As a new applicant you will need to take a placement test for english and math.
  - You are exempt from this test if you have completed college-level courses in these subjects, submit a Math SAT score of 550 or higher and Reading SAT score of 480 or higher.
  - o Make sure you send in your scores if you meet their benchmarks.
- To take the test just visit the testing center located on HACC's campus or complete the tests online with the links in your *New Student Orientation Next Steps* email.
