

General Admissions Requirements Some programs also have <u>requirements specific to the area of study.</u>

- ✓ Graduation from an approved secondary school; a diploma from an accredited home school association; *or* a GED.
 - High school courses must include a minimum of 16 units: four in English, one
 in biology, one in science with lab and two in algebra. Post-secondary
 college-level equivalents will be considered to fulfill these high school
 requirements.
 - Preferred applicants will have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or greater.
- ✓ Satisfactory scores on the SAT or ACT exam.
 - Use SAT code #2374 or ACT code #3609 to send scores directly to us.
 - Preferred applicants will have a combined reading and math score of 1000 or greater.
 - These exams are not required if more than two years have elapsed since either graduation or the earning of the GED.
- ✓ Students must also submit the following documents
 - A high school transcript or official GED transcript. Your high school transcript must have an official school stamp and include both work completed through the junior year and courses in progress during senior year.
 - Official transcripts of all educational institutions attended.
 - SAT or ACT scores.

✓ Application Deadline

- For bachelor's and master's degrees, we accept an application for college admission throughout the year as space allows.
- For associate degree and certificates:
 - o February 1 recommended Fall semester deadline
 - o August 1 recommended Spring semester deadline
- PA College accepts students on a year-round basis, so any applications received after these dates will be considered for the next applicable semester. Contact the Office of Admissions for information regarding space availability at admission@PAcollege.edu or (800) 622-5443.
