QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a high school senior.

Must be accepted as a full time student by a four year university in the USA majoring in chemical engineering beginning in the fall of 2024. The university must be fully accredited by the Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology (ABET). Check with your guidance counselor or university if you are uncertain if the university is accredited.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1) <u>Please follow instructions and provide all requested information!</u> <u>Incomplete applications will not be</u> considered for a scholarship.
- 2) Applicant must complete the first page of the application.
- 3) The school must supply documentation showing GPA, class rank, and SAT scores.
- 4) Applicant must provide proof of acceptance as a full time student by a four year university as outlined above, which includes a <u>statement confirming that you have been accepted into their chemical engineering program</u>.
- 5) Two academic letters of recommendation must be provided from different teachers. <u>Make certain the teacher uses the academic reference form supplied.</u> A generic letter of recommendation will not be accepted. <u>Each letter of recommendation should be placed in a sealed envelope by the teacher</u>. The student should include the sealed envelopes with the application in a larger envelope for mailing.
- 6) <u>ATTENTION TEACHERS: DO NOT INCLUDE A GENERIC LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION!</u> Please use only the enclosed academic reference form and answer all of the questions listed on the form. Additional sheets can be attached if needed for answering the questions.
