To be eligible for consideration an applicant shall:

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered, applicants must:

- A. Be a senior attending a secondary school that is a full member of the Lancaster-Lebanon League
- B. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) at the time of application.
- C. Provide proof of acceptance to a college, university, or trade school.
- D. Demonstrate intent to continue their education as a full-time student pursuing a post-secondary degree or certification.
- E. Be actively involved as an athlete and/or athletic support staff member (e.g., athletic training student aide, equipment manager, student manager, etc.).
- F. Exemplify at least one of Orthopedic Associates of Lancaster's core values through community service, demonstrated by a minimum of 100 completed service hours.
- G. Be available to attend the scholarship recognition event on May 11, 2026, at 7:00 PM at Lancaster Stormers Stadium.

Application Deadline:

All application materials must be submitted by April 17, 2026.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.



Application Requirements

1. Demographic Information:

- a. Full name, address, email address, and home phone number
 - b. Name, address, and phone number of high/secondary school; principal's name; athletic director's name
 - c. Current high school transcript
 - d. Letter(s) of acceptance to a college, university, or trade school

2. Applicant Essay (Maximum 500 Words)

- a. Submit a 500-word essay outlining your involvement in community service and/or volunteer activities and explaining why you believe community service is important.

3. Core Values Essay (Maximum 350 Words)

- a. Select three of Orthopedic Associates of Lancaster's core values and explain how they have influenced your high school career. (Please refer to the attached document outlining the organization's core values.)

4. Vision for the Future Essay (Maximum 200 Words)

- a. In an essay not to exceed 200 words, describe how you plan to prepare yourself to be an active and valuable member of your community after completing your secondary education.

5. Letters of Recommendation (Two Required)

- a. One letter must be from a coach, athletic trainer, athletic director, or other personnel who supervised you in your role as an athlete and/or athletic support staff member.
 - b. One letter must be from an individual who supervised or assisted you with your community service hours.
