Union Community Care charges fees for the healthcare services we provide, but there are many different payment plans and programs that keep our services affordable. We care for all patients with no insurance, some insurance, commercial insurance, Medical Assistance, or Medicare. Our Sliding Fee Discount Program is available to all patients with or without insurance based on their household income and size. No one will ever be turned away for care if they can't pay.

* Under PA State law, patients under the age of 18 can access these services without the consent of a parent or guardian. Union Community Care always encourages parental involvement.
